I. Overview/History of Department or Program

The School Resource Officer (SRO) program, coordinated through the Safe Schools Office, is essential in assisting our Districtensuring the safety of students and staff on our campuses. SROs work closely with school administrators, staff, and the District office in crime prevention and focusing on longerm solutions to ensure the safety of students, staff, parents and surrounding community members

Theprior Agreement for Peace Officer Assignment the City of Sacramento Police Department was adopted by the SCUSD Board of Education and the City of Sacramento for the 2016-2018 school yeas. The term of the Agreement was efftive September 1, 2016 through June 30, 2018 and was extended for an additional pooleth period to accommodate the District's request for Extended Summer Learning Program coverage, ending on July 31, 2018
