Regardless of the method by which public comment is submitted, including a request for oral comment, the submission deadline shall be no later than noon, February 4 for any agenda item. Individual written public comment shall be no more than two minutes in length on each agenda item. The Board shall limit the total time for public comment on each agenda item to 15 minutes in length. With Board consent, the President may increase or decrease the length of time allowed for public comment, depending on the agenda item and the number of public comments. The Board is allowed to take action only on items specifically described on the agenda as action items, unless added to the agenda as allowed by law. The Board may, in its discretion, refer a matter to district staff or calendar an agenda item for future action.
